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PULAU KUKUP NATIONAL PARK

Pulau Kukup is a 647-hectare, uninhabited mangrove island. A RAMSAR site (Wetland of International Importance), it is surrounded by 800ha of mudflats and is reputedly one of the largest-of-its-kind. It was declared a national park in 1997, in order to preserve the island's diverse variety of wetland flora and fauna.

Among its inhabitants are dusky leaf monkeys, long-tailed macaques, mud skippers as well as rare bird species and migratory birds. A monument here marks Tanjung Piai as the southernmost tip of Mainland Asia.
